At the first stage below mentioned instructions are very important for you and go through this instruction carefully. The first day of the student induction program is the orientation of the college.

Instructions for the Students regarding the Student Induction Program (SIP):

- **The 3-week Student Induction Program (SIP) is scheduled from 23-06-2025 to 11-07-2025.**
- **Induction training for 3 weeks is mandatory for first year UG Engineering students.**
- **The SIP is mandatory to attend even if the student is planning to change the institute or branch during reshuffling.** The attendance of SIP will be valid in other institutes also.
- The 3-weeks Student Induction Program will help newly admitted undergraduate students for the new stage in their life by facilitating a smooth transition from their home and school environment into the college and university environment through various discussions and activities before formal classes begin.
- In line with the thoughts expressed in the NEP 2020, the SIP consists of 9 modules – one on Universal Human Values, one on health, five on Indian Knowledge System (modules 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9) and two on skills (modules 3 and 6).

Main Objectives of the Student Induction programme:

As per the guidelines of AICTE, the institute has designed Student Induction Program (SIP) for the purpose to help new students adjust and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethos and culture of the institution, help them build bonds with other students and faculty members, and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self-exploration. The term induction is generally used to describe the whole process whereby the incumbents adjust to or acclimatize to their new roles and environment. In other words, it is a well-planned event to educate the new entrants about the environment in a particular institution and connect them with the people in it. Student Induction Program (SIP) engages with the new students as soon as they come into the institution; regular classes commence thereafter. At the start of the induction, incumbents learn about the institutional policies, processes, practices, culture and values. Thereafter, various activities start, including daily activities.

The time during the Induction Program is also used to rectify some critical lacunas, for example, English background, for those students who have deficiency in it. These are included under Proficiency Modules. As per university guidelines, the institute conducts a 3-week induction program for the UG students entering the institution, before the start of first year academics. Regular classes start after the completion of induction program. The purpose this arrangement is to make the students feel comfortable and adjust in their new environment, open them up, and set a healthy daily routine.

The main objectives of the Student Induction Programme (SIP):

- 1) Familiarisation with Institution: Introduce students to the institution's culture, values, and policies.
- 2) Academic Orientation: Familiarise students with academic rules, regulations, and expectations.
- 3) Transition Support: Help students transition from school to college/university life.
- 4) Building Relationships: Encourage bonding among students, faculty, and staff.
- 5) Setting Expectations: Clarify expectations regarding academic performance, attendance, and extracurricular activities.
- 6) Resource Utilisation: Introduce students to campus resources, such as libraries, laboratories, and support services.
- 7) Motivation and Inspiration: Motivate and inspire students to achieve their academic and personal goals.
- 8) Reducing Anxiety: Reduce anxiety and stress associated with transitioning to a new academic environment.

Main Benefits to Students:

- 1) Smooth Transition: Helps students adjust to college/university life.
- 2) Improved Academic Performance: Sets clear expectations and promotes academic success.
- 3) Increased Engagement: Fosters student engagement and participation in campus life.
- 4) Support Network: Provides students with a support network of peers, faculty, and staff.
